July 20, 2015

PURSUANT TO A.R.S. 38.431.02, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC THAT THE SUPERSTITION FIRE & MEDICAL DISTRICT ("SFMD") PUBLIC SAFETY PERSONNEL RETIREMENT SYSTEM ("PSPRS"), THE LOCAL PENSION BOARD HELD A MEETING ON TUESDAY, APRIL 7, 2015. THE MEETING WAS HELD AT THE SUPERSTITION FIRE & MEDICAL DISTRICT'S ADMINISTRATION OFFICE, AT 565 N. IDAHO ROAD, APACHE JUNCTION, ARIZONA. THE MEETING WAS OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND BEGAN AT 4:05 P.M.

- A. Chairperson Gene Gehrt called the meeting to order at 4:03 p.m.
- B. Rueben Briones was sworn in by Assistant Chief Mike Farber to fill the Local Pension Board position vacated by Ryan Philips who resigned his Board position effective April 2, 2015.

On May 27, 2015, a communication was sent to all public safety personnel at SFMD asking for the name(s) of those interested in serving on the Local Pension Board to fill the vacant position. Rueben Briones communicated his interest. Rueben's term will end on December 31, 2016.
